The Huntley Meadows Park Youth Birding Club is a program developed to educate, encourage and enable our youth to become informed conservationists. Each month student members can join a birding walk in the park with a naturalist. In addition to on site hikes, we will have several opportunities during the year to explore other great birding areas in Northern Virginia and beyond. Also members will have a chance to participate in service projects focused on habitat restoration and other cool projects such as creating bird friendly areas at the park.

- Foster an interest in natural history and encourage young people to spend more time outside
